THE KINGS DAUGHTERS & SONS ELIZABETH KELLY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION COMMITTEE

The following are criteria to be given consideration by the scholarship committee in making its decision. Extraordinary or unusual circumstances may affect the weight given by the committee to any one or more criteria.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 1. Applicant must live in Des Moines County and have been accepted at, or applied for acceptance at, any accredited college.
- 2. A student must have reasonably good passing grades.
- 3. Applicant's financial need will be considered.
- 4. Applicant must possess good character in the estimation of either high school or college faculty and employer or pastor.
- 5. Applicant must apply for the scholarship by timely completing an application and provide on it true and correct information to the best of her/his knowledge.

AWARD OF AND CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP IN SECOND AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS:

- 1. A student must be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college.
- 2. A student must maintain a minimum achievement level of not less than a C+ average. A transcript of grades must be provided to the trustee following the end of each semester to prove the condition has been fulfilled.
- 3. A student must be making progress toward a degree.
- 4. A student must carry a full-time class schedule during each year she/he receives the scholarship.

5. To receive consideration for second and subsequent years, the student must complete a new application form and submit a transcript of grades for the college level sources that have been completed. This scholarship is not automatically renewable.

REVOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. A student's scholarship will be revoked if she/he does not meet the minimum conditions for receipt or continuation of the scholarship.
- 2. The trustee may revoke or cancel a scholarship for good cause.
